

## Report:

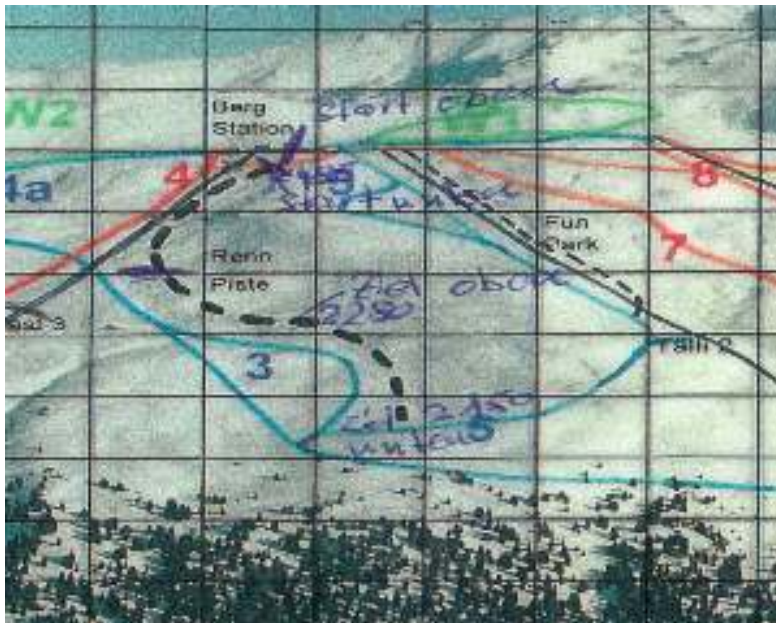
