1. Technical Committee

The technical committee will be composed of the EDSO Technical Official and members appointed by the Organising Committee (OC):

- 1.1. The Technical Committee will be composed of as follows:
 - Valery Rukhledev EDSO Representative Official
 - **Dmitry Antonov** EDSO Technical Official of Wrestling, Ukraine
 - **Ivan Kulakov** Sports Coordinator of Competitions, Ukraine
 - Valery Padalets Main Judges of Competitions, Ukraine
 - **Gennady Gusev** Main Secretary of Competitions, Ukraine

2. Jury of Appeal

The Jury of Appeal will be composed of as follows:

- Valery Rukhledev EDSO Representative Official
- **Dmitry Antonov** EDSO Technical Official of Wrestling, Ukraine
- Valery Padalets Main Judges of Competitions, Ukraine

3. Technical Meeting

- 3.1. A technical meeting will be held on a date at a place to be announced to the participating teams before or after their arrival.
- 3.2. The meeting will be conducted in International Signs only.
- 3.3. Each participating National Federation may be represented by two officials, of whom at least one should be deaf and, if necessary, one interpreter.

4. Competition Venue

The Wrestling competitions will take place at Sport Complex SCA (Sport Club of Army) in Bila Cerkva, Ukraine.

5. Training Venue

The training sites are the same as the competition venue.

6. Equipment

All equipment used during competitions will comply with the FILA Rules and Regulations. The Wrestling area will be configured to international standards.

7. Events

The wrestling competitions include Greco-Roman and Freestyle Wrestling. The wrestling competitions will consist of the following events:

- 1. Up to 55 kg
- 2. Up to 60 kg;
- 3. Up to 66 kg;
- 4. Up to 74 kg;
- 5. Up to 84 kg;
- 6. Up to 96 kg;
- 7. Up to 120 kg

8. Schedule

Refer to competition schedule included on the EDSO site.

9. General Rules

- 9.1. The Greco-Roman and Freestyle competitions will be organized in accordance with the FILA Rules.
- 9.2. Any unforeseen occurrences not covered by the rules shall be regulated as follows:
 - 9.2.1. Cases of general nature shall be regulated in accordance with the EDSO Statutes and Regulations.

 In case of collisions between versions at different languages, English text shall prevail.
 - 9.2.2. Technical questions shall be settled according to FILA Rules. In case of collisions between versions at different languages, English text shall prevail.
 - 9.2.3. Only athletes who comply with the EDSO Rules and Regulations are entitled to take part in the European Deaf Greco-Roman and Freestyle Championships.

10. Participants

10.1. Each National Deaf Federation may enter one (1) wrestler per weight class, in each style, for

maximum of 14 participants.

- 10.2. All wrestlers must be at least 18 years old in 2007 (born in 1989 or before).
- 10.3. Wrestlers aged 18 in 2007 must provide a medical certificate and parental authorization.

11. Entries

- 11.1. The final registrations with the names of each athlete indicating weight class entered must be submitted to the EDSO Official Representative Mr. Valery Rukhledev no later than **8 August 2007**.
 - 11.2. No changes or additional entries will be accepted after **8 August 2007**.
- 11.3. A fine of 50 Euros is levied on each non-starting athlete with the exception of those presenting a doctor's declaration that he should not be allowed to start.

12. Medical Control

13. Competition Rules and Regulations

13.1. Technical Organization

Organizing Committee is responsible for the technical organization of the Wrestling competitions.

13.2. Weigh-in & Medical Examination

Freestyle Wrestling

20 September 2007. 17.00 - 18.00 - Medical examination

21 September 2007. 17.00 - 18.00 - Medical examination

18.00 - 18.30 - Weigh-in - 55 kg, 66 kg, 84 kg, 120 kg

<u>17 September 2007</u> for weight classes: 60 kg, 74 kg, 96 kg; <u>18 September 2007</u> for weight classes: 55 kg, 66 kg, 84 kg, 120 kg.

Freestyle Wrestling

<u>20 September 2007</u> for weight classes: 60 kg, 74 kg, 96 kg; <u>21 September 2007</u> for weight classes: 55 kg, 66 kg, 84 kg, 120 kg.

13.4. Judges Referees and Mat Chairmen

Nomination of the competition officials will be made by the Technical Committee.

- **13.5.** In accordance with the FILA Rules, the competition officials will be appointed by the Technical Committee.
- **13.6.** According to Article 13 of the FILA Rules, there will be assigned three competition officials to each match: a mat chairman, a judge and a referee.
 - **13.7.** The necessary support personnel will be provided by the Organising Committee.

14. Protests

- 14.1. All sport related protests will be resolved in accordance to the FILA Rules and Regulations and will be managed by the Jury of Appeal.
- 14.2. Any official protest must be submitted in writing (English) on the Official EDSO Protest Form, and given to Jury of Appeal accompanied by 50 Euros within 30 (thirty) minutes after taking decision.
 - 14.3. The decision of the Jury of Appeal is final.

15. Clothing

Contestants must appear on the edge of the mat wearing a one-piece singlet of the colour assigned to them (red or blue); the singlet may be of any design. It is forbidden to have within the singlet fabric a mixture of red and blue colours. For more detailed information please refer to FILA handbook page 15, article 8.

16. Hearing Aids

The use of hearing aids or external cochlear implant aids is strictly forbidden during the competition.
