*The Stadium Zawisza (2007-2008 General renovations) with a seating capacity of 15,000 people and a standing capacity of 30,000, is one of the prettiest Stadiums in Poland and at the Same Time the largest in Bydgoszcz.*

*In the green part, there are training grounds, tennis Courts, and the target range for small-Calibre luxshotguns and sports hall with gyms, an indoor running track, a cafe and a hotel for 170 guests. The stadium was a lot of international races in athletics.*

*Lighting: 1600 lux*



Stadium - Available dressing rooms, room for accreditation, technical advice, anti-doping room. There is a rehabilitation center, gym, sauna etc.

Tour of the stadium area, near restaurants, hotel everything is within 5 minutes walk.

Training area (outdoor) is next to the stadium, in case of rain is covered training area - the tunnel.

Restaurants near the stadium, next to the training area. Possibility of lunch, dinner.

The hotel is within sportkomplex Zawisza 50 m behind the stadium, accommodation with breakfast. There is hi-fi, TV Sat.



At the meeting were agreed areas for judges, for EDSO and others as needed.

Conclusion: our requirements fully accepted.

**11.30 hours** meeting with the Krzysztof Wolsztyński , the President region's provinces Kujawa Association of Athletics and Vice President (organizationally financial) Polish Association of Athletics.
