## Important Technical information

Now the draw had been taken place in Essen, Germany on the 18<sup>th</sup> June 2010.

I had already mention that the Technical Regulation are subject to change and the schedule will be send out to participating teams within the one month.

## <u>MEN</u>

- To qualify from Group stage to Knockout stage, there will be 16 teams to go through from Group stage for 1<sup>st</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup> place.
- 2. Top two teams from each group will go through to Knockout for  $1^{st} 16^{th}$  place.
- 3. Four third placed teams from any other groups, with better goal average, highest goal and lowest goal will go through for  $1^{st} 16^{th}$  place.
- 4. Remaining 8 teams from Group stage will go through for  $17^{th} 24^{th}$  places.
- 5. Last 2 teams MAY go though for 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> places, subject to schedule.

## <u>WOMEN</u>

- 1. To qualify from Group stage to Knockout stage, there will be 8 teams to go through from Group stage for  $1^{st} 8^{th}$  place.
- 2. Top two teams from each group will go through to Knockout for  $1^{st} 8^{th}$  place.
- 3. Remaining two third placed teams, with better goal average, highest goal and lowest goal will go through for  $1^{st} 8^{th}$  place.
- 4. Remaining 4 teams from Group stage will go through for 9th 12<sup>th</sup> places.
- 5. Last 2 teams MAY go though for 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> places, subject to schedule.
