# Technical Regulations Ninepin Bowling Classic

Celje, Slovenija 23<sup>th</sup> - 28<sup>th</sup> June 2014

Updated: 17 Feb 2014

#### 1. EVENTS

Ninepin Bowling Classic competitions will comprise the following events:

Men's and Women's Teams competition Men's and Women's individual singles Men's and Women's sprint tandems Men's and Women's sprint singles

### 2. PARTICIPANTS

## 2.1. Age Eligibility

There are no age restrictions for ninepin Bowling classic competitors.

## 2.2. Number of Players

Each National Federation may enter a maximum number of ten (10) men and eight (8) women for the Ninepin Bowling Classic competition. It is required to enter a minimum of four (4) men and three (3) women for team event competition.

**2.3.** A fine of EURO €20 is levied on each non-starting athlete with the exception of those presenting a doctor's declaration that he/she should not be allowed to start.

# 3. REGISTRATION

# 3.1. Preliminary Registration

The preliminary registrations with an indication of the probable number of athletes in each event must be submitted to the EDSO Representative no later than **23 December 2013.** [Not less than one (1) year before the competition.]

## 3.2. Final Entry

The final entries with the names of each athlete indicating event entered must be submitted to the EDSO Representative no later than **31 January 2014.** [Not less than three (3) months before the competition] Such submissions will be made via official online registration form or telefax followed by the official registration form.

# 3.3. Name Registration

The name Registration with the names of each athlete indicating event entered must be submitted to the EDSO Representative no later than 23 May 2014. [Not less than one (1) month before the competitions.] Such submissions will be made via official online registration form or telefax followed by the official registration form.

3.3.1. No changes or additional entries will be accepted after 23 May 2014.

#### 4. COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS

# 4.1. Technical Organisation

EDSO is responsible for the technical organisation of the (Sport) competitions.

## 4.3. Competition Rules

The (Sport) competitions will be conducted in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the **NBC** (statues **2013** In case of disagreement in the interpretation of the Rules and Regulations, the English text shall prevail. Unforeseen incidents not covered by the Rules and Regulations shall be dealt with as follows:

- **4.3.1.** Cases of a general nature will be resolved in accordance with EDSO Regulations, EDSO General Technical Rules and this (Sport) Technical Regulations.
- **4.3.2.** Technical questions related to competition rules shall be resolved according to the **NBC** Rules and Regulations.
- **4.3.3.** Only athletes who comply with the EDSO Regulations are entitled to take part in the EDSO (Sport) competitions.

## 4.4. Competition Equipment

- **4.4.1.** All equipment and implements used during competitions will comply with the **NBC** Rules and Regulations.
- 4.4.2. For the sport enterprise/matches only balls, which are from the WNBA certified, may be used. Balls by the hall operator are to be used in principle. Own balls are not permit.

## 4.5. Competition Clothing

**4.5.1.** By all international sporting events may be started only with uniformly Sportswear and playing dress =

playing dress: tricot, short/skirt, socks

sportswear: playing dress and training clothing If teams are given, this concerns all athletes and athletes support personnel.

The coloured design of playing dress is liable to no regulations. In justified exceptions the wear of the same coloured short and/or shorts of driver of bicycles respectively short shirts or skirts can be acknowledged as uniform flaying dress.

The national or the federation coats of arms (front) and the name of nation (back) have to be on the tricot of national teams and individual athletes, which are starting for your nation.

- 4.5.2. Advertisement may be carried on the sportswear. The surface of advertisement for every single adverting may not be greater as 400 cm<sup>2</sup>. Advertising of alcohol (expected beer) and tobacco goods is not allowed.

## 4.7. Competition Plan

## 4.7.1. Teams Event

Men's team up to seven (7) players for a team with 4 players.

Of that may come to play in the team:

Five players (four players by name attached to the starting-places 1 to 4 and one substitute is not yet attached out of the rest of the named four players).

Women's team up to six (6) for a team with 3 players Of that may come to play in the team:

Four players (three players by name attached to the starting-places 1 to 3 and one substitute is not yet attached out of the rest of the named three players).

Single's and sprint single's at a time 32 starters for men's Single's and sprint single's at a time 16 starters for women's

It is to play K.O.-System Sprint Single's vs Sprint single's by schedule. Each Sprint single's is every round has to play 1 x 40 balls combine (2 set with 20 balls) across two lanes.

## 4.7.2.1. Classification of Players

Winner of match is Sprint single's and sprint tandem for men's and Women's with 2 set point or Winner "Sudden Victory" across the lanes played in the end, if equality of set points (1:1).

## 4.7.3. Sprint Tandem

Sprint tandem at a time 16 starters for men's Sprint tandem at a time 8 starters for women's

It is to play K.O.-System Sprint tandem vs Sprint tandem by schedule. Each Sprint tandem is every round has to play  $1 \times 60$  balls combine (2 set with 30 balls) across two lanes

## 4.8. Officials

#### 4.8.1. Referee

The referee shall be fully qualified and certified by the NBA. The referee Shall act in concert with the EDSO Technical Officer. However, in matters concerning the interpretation of the Rules of Ninepin Bowling Classic, the referee's decision shall be finals.

## 6.3. Technical Meeting

## 6.3.1. Date and Location

The first Technical Meeting will be held at 23<sup>th</sup> June, 3.00 p.m., Lanteks Celje The second Technical Meeting will be held at 26<sup>th</sup> June, 2.00 p.m., Lanteks Celje

## 6.3.2. Attendance

Each participating National Federation may be represented by two (2) officials, of whom at least one (1) must be deaf and, if necessary, an interpreter.

# 7. CONTROL AND SANCTIONS

## 7.1. Hearing Devices

The use of any hearing devices(s)/amplification or external cochlear implant parts is strictly forbidden from the restricted zone area.

## 7.1.1. Restricted Zone Area

The restricted zone area is in effect from the time athletes enter on the whole (Sport) courts hall area during the warm-up and competition period.

#### 7.1.2. Violation and Penalty

When this rule is violated, the match shall immediately be stopped and the offending player/s will be disqualified from the event. Refer to ICSD <u>Audiogram Regulations</u>, 8: Violations and Penalties.

## 8. PROTESTS

## 8.1. Procedure for lodging a protest

All sport related protests will be resolved in accordance to the BWF Rules and Regulations and will be managed by the (Sport) Protest Committee. Any official protest must be submitted in writing in English on the Official EDSO Protest Form. The form must be given to the EDSO Technical Officer with EURO €50 within sixty (60) minutes after official posted results.

**8.1.1.** The EDSO Technical Officer will decide whether the protest is sporting related eligibility related. The (Sport) Protest Committee will review all sport related protests, and the EDSO Executive Committee will review all eligibility protests. The deposit of EURO €50 will be returned to the appellant only if the protest is considered valid.

# 8.2. Procedures for reviewing a protest

The **Ninepin Bowling Classic** Protest Committee will meet in the Technical Officer's office in **Lanteks Celje** at a time decided upon by the chairperson of the committee.

• The EDSO Representative will be the chairperson of the committee.

- The Sports Liaison Officer (SLO) will be responsible to book the meeting room and interpreters.
- The Sports Liaison Officer (SLO) will contact all committee members to inform them of the meeting time and location.
- The EDSO Technical Officer will be responsible for liaising with the State Sports Association's Competition Manager.
- The Sports Liaison Officer (SLO) will be responsible for informing the hosting Deaf Sport Federation and the EDSO Technical Officer will be responsible for informing EDSO Executive Committee about the protest and also the outcome of the protest.
