Report from inspection visit August 2007 EC Orienteering Championships for the Deaf in Estonia in 2008

Thursday August 23.

Arrival to Tallinn. Had meeting with the chairman of Estonian Deaf Sport Union.

Friday August 24.

We drove to Võru with chairman Riina Kuusk, sportsconsultation Triin Pollisinski and interpreter. We visited to the accommodations in hotel "Kubija" out of Võru approx. 3 km and this is very good facilities on the spot and they promised good reasonable price for sportsman. We met chairman of the Võru Orienteering Club. Went through and explained each listed topic of the checklist, that they had to use as organizers of the EC Orienteering Championships for the Deaf in 2008 and we will arrange also with both Junior and Masters and we discussed more details of our competition rules. We visited the city councils representative in sport affairs and they promised to take bus of transport to the participants and deliver flags etc. They took me out to look at the sites and facilities. There were 2 (two) forests in a distance of approx. 10 km around Võru – which there will be held competitions in long distance, middle distance and relay. I was satisfied with the form of the forests and the terrain is good. Conditions are international because they had Baltic Orienteering for hearing in 2004. Then we drove back to Tallinn.

Saturday August 25.

Departure back to Copenhagen.

Concluding comments:

My opinion is that Estonian Deaf Sport Union did a good job and believe that they will arrange a good EC Orienteering in 2008.
