Bulletin Nr. 2 10th European Swimming Championships of the Deaf 2010 in Dortmund/GER

General Information

Up to now 43 men and 38 women from 20 countries have entered athletes for the European Swimming Championships of the Deaf from 20 to 26 June 2010 in Dortmund.

OC-office – Accreditation

The accreditation will take place on **19 June 2010 16:00 – 18:00 hrs** and on **20 June from 09:00 – 15:00 hrs** at the Südbad in Dortmund. Two officials of each team will be taken from the hotel to the accreditation approximately 20min before accreditation. You will have to bring all passports of athletes and officials and the participation-fee that has to be paid to the EDSO.

We will adjust the times for accreditation to the arrival times of the countries. Please send photographs of all participants for accreditation to us **before 20 May 2010**.

Training

Trainingtimes will be offered on 19 June from 14:00 – 18:00 hrs and on 20 June from 09:00 – 15:00. All eight lanes will be available for training. On 20 June we will also give you the opportunity for starting-tests.

Hotels – Accommodation

Please note that the reservation-deadlines for some hotels already expired. Your reservations must be made **directly with your chosen hotel**, not through DGS. For smooth local transport please inform us about the hotel you have booked. Please use the attached **form** to tell us which hotel you have booked and about your time of arrival and departure. Thank you.

Local transport of the delegations – hotel – swimming pool – hotel – and to and from train station/airport on arrival and departure will only be provided if you book your rooms in the official hotels we suggested.

Visa

The following countries have to apply for visa:

Russia, Belarus, Ukraine, Turkey and Moldova.

For participants from these countries we need the following data as soon as possible:

Name, surname, date of birth, passport-no., hotel-reservation.

Attached you will find the form that you need to complete and send to us via e-mail.

If you apply for visa at the German embassy you will need to prove that you have contracted medical insurance. The earlier we receive the list of participants the easier it will be to support you with you application for visa.

Opening ceremony

The European Swimming-Championships will be opened with a small celebration at the Südbad on Sunday, 20 June at 17:00 hrs.

Technical Meeting

The first Technical Meeting will take place at the Südbad on 19 June at 19:00 hrs. Delegates (two people per team) will be picked up at their hotel between 18:15 and 18:30 hrs.

Health Insurance

We recommend that you contract medical insurance for travel because in Germany you will have to pay cash for medical treatment in case of injuries or illness.
