Fina reaffirms ban bathing suits

The Federal Fina Swimming World has a ban on super-fast swim suits ratified. Swimming may be decided by the new rule only of 'textile' made. A technical committee to determine what exactly means textile. Then there are also rules for material thickness, buoyancy and water resistance. The Fina, the rules in January 2010 to go.

The decision last July in Roma (ITA) also limits to what part of the body of the pool may be covered. Thus, swimmers under the new rules only swimwear bear up to the knee to extend. For swimmer, the swim suits or pipes may have, but that may only come to the knee. Arms and shoulders should remain uncovered.
