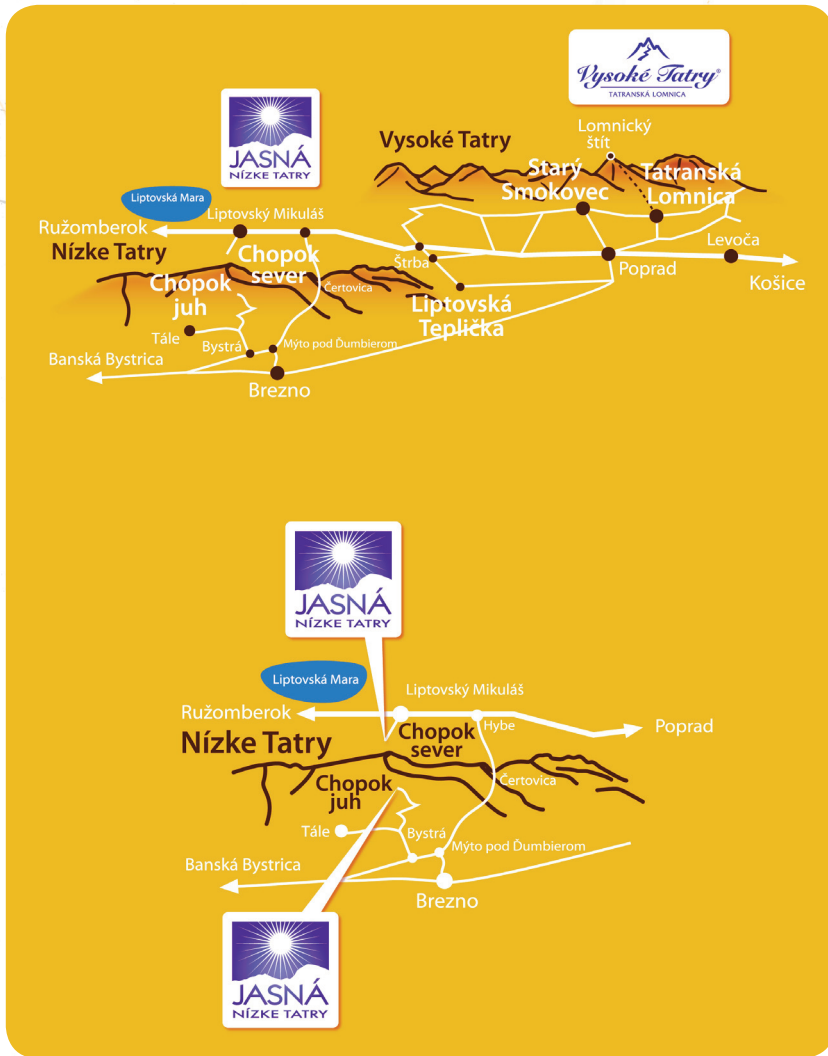

GENERAL INFORMATION

Slovak Republic

Slovakia is a young country, existing from the 1st January 1993. The capital city of Slovakia is Bratislava, located in the southwest of the country, very close to Vienna. Slovakia has more than 5 million inhabitants and is a member of the European Union.

Slovakia is a country which has a right to be the heart of Europe not only from the geographical point of view but also because of its historical and cultural tradition, beautiful nature of Vysoké and Nízke Tatry mountains with almost untouched nature, crystal clear streams and lakes, large forests and protected flora and fauna.

Venue: Demänovská dolina - Jasná

Mountains: Nízke Tatry (*Low Tatras*), the National Park, the northern and southern slopes of Chopok

GPS coordinates: N 48 58 15.1 19 34 48.1

Altitude: 900 - 2024 meters above the sea level

Jasná in Nízke Tatry is the largest sporting and recreation resort in Slovakia, with the best natural presumptions for skiing and snowboarding. There are:

- extensive accommodation and catering facilities
- perfectly prepared slopes of various difficulties
- 17 cableways and lifts (16.430 persons/hour)
- professional snow-making systems which guarantee snow for 5 months of the year
- the winter season lasts from the beginning of December to the end of April.

The European Cups will be held in the part of Jasná called "Chopok - sever" (*Chopok - north*) which is divided into 3 smaller resorts linked by cableways and lifts:

Resort Záhradky 900-2004 meters above the sea level
Resort Biela púť 1117-2004 meters above the sea level
Resort Otupné 1141-2004 meters above the sea level

ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation for each expedition is provided directly in the venue of the European Cups, in Jasná resort.

The price of accommodation is 20 EUR/day/double room. In case of single occupancy the price is 20 EUR/day too. An extra bed is 15 EUR/day. These prices are guaranteed for each European country delegation of at least 6 people.

Hotel Ski**

This two star hotel is located in the ski centre Záhradky, at an altitude of 998 meters above the sea level. In the immediate surroundings of the hotel, there is the favourite and internationally recognized ski track FIS. For more information visit www.hotelski.jasna.sk

Guest house Energetik ***

This pleasant guest house is located in the centre of Demänovská dolina (Demänovská valley), 700 metres from the ski resort Záhradky. For more information visit www.penzionenergetik.sk

Hotel 3 studničky

In this hotel there will be the seat of the Organizing Committee, a services centre and a place of registration and drawing of the starting numbers for Super G. You can find all information on www.tristudnicky.sk
