3. TRANING VENUE

The training venue is the same as the competition venue. Training process carried out according to schedule.

4. EQUIPMENT

All equipment (mats for wrestling, electronic scoreboard) matches with all international standards.

5. COMPETITION AMOUNG ADULTS

The tournament includes Greco Roman and Freestyle wrestling. Each style consists of 7 weight categories:

- 1. up to 55 kg
- 2. up to 60 kg
- 3. up to 66 kg
- 4. up to 74 kg
- 5. up to 84 kg
- 6. up to 96 kg
- 7. up to 120 kg

7. COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATION

I European Championships in Greco Roman and Freestyle Wrestling Among Deaf conducted in accordance with the FILA Rules and Regulations. In case of disagreement in the interpretation of the Rules, the English text shall prevail. Unforeseen incidents not covered by the Rules and Regulations shall be dealt with as follows:

- 1. Cases of a general nature will be resolved in accordance with to EDSO Rules and Regulations.
- 2. Technical questions related to competition rules shall be resolved according to the FILA Rules and Regulations.
- Only athletes who comply with the EDSO Rules and Regulations are entitled to take part in I European Championships in Greco Roman and Freestyle Wrestling Among Deaf.

8. PARTICIPANTS

1. In competition among adults, National Association may enter one wrestler in one weight category in each style – maximum 14 athletes.

9 .LICENSE

For participation in competition each athlete must be licensed by FILA. Which he may buy in Wrestling Federation of host country.

10. APPLICATIONS

- 1. Name-registration and function should be send to EDSO Official Representative by **1 September 2011**.
- 2. No changes or additional entries will be accepted after **1 September 2011.**
- 3. Penalty charges at EUR €50 will be adjust for those athletes who miss the competition. Except, when athletes has a doctor's note, due to which he could not get into the competition.
- 4. Medical monitoring (due to FILA Rules and Regulations).

13. REFEREE

Technical Committee shall appoint referees.

14. PROTESTS

Any official protests must be submitted in writing in English on the Official EDSO Protest Form. The form must be given to the EDSO Technical Director with EUR €50 within 30 minutes after official results.

15. UNIFORM

Wrestlers should have tricot, approved by FILA Rules and Regulations, appropriate colors red or blue. Tricot with mixed colors of blue and red is forbidden.

On tricot, wrestler should have:

- The coat of arm of his country on his chest
- Acronym of country, and surname of wrestler on his back (max 10x10 cm)

16. Hearing Aids

During fight not permitted using of any hearing aid/amplification or external cochlear implant parts.

17. TECHNICAL MEETING

Technical Meeting is held at a time and place announced for participating countries by the OC.

Each participating National Federation may be represented by two officials, of whom at lest one must be deaf, if necessary, an interpreter.
